

RESOLUTION 06-01

WEST CENTRAL CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION MODIFYING DISTRICT POLICY CONCERNING
CREDIT FOR RESIDENTIAL USER'S TEMPORARY TERMINATION CREDIT

Whereas the Board of Directors ("Board") of the West Central Conservancy District ("District") amended the District's Rate Resolution 02-02 on September 4, 2002, when the Board adopted and passed Resolution 02-06 which instituted a credit for Residential Users when the Residential User temporarily disconnected their water service; and

Whereas it has come to the Boards attention that the District's requirement that water service in fact be disconnected during an extended absence from the Residential User's dwelling is inconvenient to the District's Residential User, causes additional expense to the customer and in some cases the Residential User cannot disconnect water service; and

Whereas the District can accomplish the intent of Subsection II of Section 3(B) of Rate Resolution 02-02 in a manner that is more convenient for its customers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WEST CENTRAL CONSERVANCY DISTRICT.

Section 1. To receive the Temporary Termination Credit as provided in Rate Resolution Section 3 B II the Residential User shall be required to complete an affidavit signed and acknowledged that the statement made in the affidavit and relied on by the District are made under the penalties for perjury. The affidavit shall certify the period of time of the Residential User's temporary

absence from the dwelling unit and certify there was no occupancy of the dwelling unit during the timeframe stated.

Section 2. The minimum time frame for which a Temporary Termination Credit shall be permitted is thirty (30) days.

Section 3. All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as defined in Resolution 02-02, as amended.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
