WEST CENTRAL CONSERVANCY DISTRICT POLICY #2007 – 2 MANDATORY CONNECTION

TO THE DISTRICT'S SEWER SYSTEM AFTER THE INSTALLATION OF SEWER SERVICE IN EXISTING SUBDIVISIONS

The Board of Directors of the West Central Conservancy District recognizes that there is a need to protect the public health and welfare of the freeholders of the District by eliminating the use of septic systems in existing subdivisions after the District has caused public sewer service to be available in the subdivision. From and after the date of the adoption of this District Policy, after the District has constructed sewers in an existing subdivision, it shall be the policy of the District that all properties exceptionally benefited by that construction shall be required to connect the property to the District's sewer system and require the discontinuance of the use of privies, cesspools, septic tanks and similar structures within twelve (12) months of substantial completion of the construction project. The Board adopts this policy pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 14-33-5-21(a)(4) and may enforce the provisions of this policy as provided in I.C. 36-9-
