A. Hux recommended change in Section 13, effective date.

A. Hux discussed the Harlan Encroachment Agreement the District has received from Mr. Harlan with the Board and indicated several issues that should be added to the agreement and recommended the Board consider receiving a monetary amount as compensation for granting the encroachment.

The Board, by consensus, directed Mr. Hux to proceed with finalizing the Agreement.

The Board discussed Resolution 02-03, a resolution approving length of assessment and interest rate on exceptional benefit assessment for Sugarwood Estates, Sections one and

two, and property commonly referred to as the Catholic Archdiocese Property.

Motion by P. Allen, second by K. Buetow, vote unanimous, to approve Resolution 02-03 as amended by changing the officer titles, as appropriate, for the Board.

R. Goff recommended the Board consider initiating a Common Construction Wage Committee in view of pending projects of the District.

The Board, by consensus, took recommendation under advisement for further action at a future Board Meeting.
